The one-day event, supported by **RenewableUK**, will explore the **current and future subsea cables** market with a strong emphasis on industry challenges including the transition from fixed and floating offshore wind. Recent challenges facing the sector will be examined and the debate will explore how industry needs to lead the innovation in the development of dynamic cables.

Cables 2023 will bring together delegates from across the industry supply chain, including cable manufacturers and installers, vessel operators, planners, offshore wind developers, grid specialists and verification bodies, offering an excellent platform for networking, learning and dialogue with industry colleagues.

Conference sessions will focus on:
